### CHAPTER 3. AIR QUALITY ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY

Quantifying the effects of exposure to air pollution in terms of public health has become a critical component in policy discussion. WHO/Europe's software tool AirQ+ performs calculations that allow quantification of the health effects of exposure to air pollution, including estimates of the reduction in life expectancy. When environmental regulations of carbon emissions and air pollution increased by 1%, green technology innovation as measured by green technology invention patent applications increased by 0.173% and 0.128% respectively. The magnitude of the correlation coefficient is larger for CO2 emissions than for air pollution.
