Bees, along with some birds, reptiles and other insects, can see near-ultraviolet light reflecting off of plants. Bug zappers attract insects with ultraviolet light to lure them to the trap. What is UV Light? Ultraviolet (UV) light has shorter wavelengths than visible light. Although UV waves are invisible to the human eye, some insects, such as bumblebees, can see them.
